The conference theme, "Promoting Access and Indigeneity in Pacific Archives, Libraries, and Museums," aims to foster important conversations and initiatives around preserving our cultural identities while promoting access to knowledge and heritage resources across our Pacific Island communities. We believe this theme closely aligns with your ongoing work and advocacy in the region, and your insights would be invaluable to our members and regional partners. The 34th Annual PIALA Conference consists of 4 full days of event-filled activities held on November 24th -27th, 2025. We will be expecting close to 100+ attendees from across the Pacific --Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, Hawaii, Republic of Marshall Islands, Republic of Palau, Federated States of Micronesia (Chuuk, Yap, Kosrae, and Pohnpei), New Zealand, and American Samoa) and the U.S. Mainland. Attendees will be composed of librarians, school librarians, library workers, archivists, educators, scientists, high school/middle school students/college students, museum curators, cultural practitioners, academics, Parliament members, and various community stakeholders/partners.
